BigInteger result = new BigInteger(stuff[0]);

      String operator = stuff[i];
      BigInteger operand = new BigInteger(stuff[i+1]);
      // Case 1: Addition
      if (operator.equals("+"))
        {
            result = result.add(operand);
        } // "+"
      // Otherwise, it's not a valid operator
      else
        {
            throw new Exception("Invalid operator: " + operator);
        } // if not a valid operator
    }
